The Mason County Community Seed Library is a donation-based free garden seed program dedicated to increasing the ability to feed, educate, and build our community. We are committed to promoting the importance of homegrown fruits, herbs, and vegetables while also including native plants and non-invasive flowers in your landscape.

A library card is not required to become a member. After completing a membership form, you may take up to 6 packets of seeds per week, with no limit per year. This weekly limit does apply to both branches (Ludington and Scottville) as a whole. Anyone in your household, 10 years and older, can become a member with a guardian's permission. There's no need to reapply each year – your form will be on file for the entirety of the Seed Library.

We do encourage members to learn basic seed-saving skills so they're able to take packets with the intention of sharing saved seeds after their harvest. If you are unable to save your own, please consider donating fresh, commercially grown, open-pollinated (non-hybrid / non-GMO) seeds to keep our library well stocked. This is not mandatory.

Any donation of invasive plant seeds will not be accepted. Please note: the seed displays are stocked to reflect our local planting calendar. When taking seeds, be sure to log the codes, including quantities for our inventory.
